About cookies on our website

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we place onto a user's device. It is used to tailor the user experience either for the duration of their visit (using what is known as a session cookie) or for repeat visits (whereby we store what is known as a persistent cookie).

We also use "analytical" cookies which allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how these users move around our website.

Are cookies Safe?

Session

This type only lasts for the duration you are on the website.

Persistent
